 - a. School Org
 - i. Two factors impacting school org are

 - ii. 472 students and 20 divisions for 2017-18 school year
 - iii. Hiring
 - 1. 1 LA,
 - 2. 2 classroom teachers,
 - 3. 1 partial LA position and
 - 4. 1 person is on leave until Christmas
 - b. We will also be receiving a special student learning grant
 - i. Potential for gym equipment
 - ii. Potential for school hand tool kits
 - iii. Special Education material (including seating)
 - iv. Robotics are being explored
 - v. Value is \$22,000 and can be carried over to next year
 - vi. The PAC will be sharing in this plan in May 2017

 - ii. The school ordered some school kits as well last year
 - iii. Agendas will be ordered from Premier through the School District

 - ii. The number of French Immersion teachers is in a bit of a crisis there is a shortage
 - iii. Duchess in 2018-19 will be overfull due to a bubble of grade 6 students coming through the system
 - iv. In October DPAC will be offering a Food Safe program look at their website for more information
 - v. Across BC, 49% of students cannot read adequately at a grade 2 level. Some reasons include stresses due to poverty.
