 - -Bookings for gym rules have changed PAC events do not have priority over general bookings, but most PAC events are school events (which do get priorty) so will be of no effect

- -Primary laptops are coming and will be operational soon so there will be 3 computer labs in total (1 stationary and 2 mobile)
- CAT testing happening for some students now
- -HVAC replacement happening so by next year all should be replaced
- Kindergarten reg 3 classes of 20 and 17 on the waitlist
