## Funding Requests:

1. Monique asked to consider providing each division with 100 dollars next year as it was much appreciated by teachers who used the money to buy classroom supplies. Melissa mentioned this was done in the past and could be looked at by the next executive in September.

## Old Business

1. We've got an almost approved work order for the gaga ball court. Maintenance made some suggestions to reduce costs. We're meeting with Maintenance to finalize the location of the Court. This will be constructed this year.

Motion: To fund the Gaga Ball court construction, with an instruction sign and spot for a ball for $\$ 6000$ being funded through the General Bank account.

Tara first's the motion and Richard seconds, Motion Approved
2. The mural is still a work in progress. Our new artist drew up a design that we will need to pay for if we cannot get approval for the mural by June. School District 57 is holding PAC money for the painting and installation of the mural. As we are unsure if the mural will be completed, PAC will request the money to be returned.

Motion: For $\$ 500$ to be available out of general to pay Erin Stagg for the design of the school mural. Richard first the motion and Shana seconds, Motion Approved
3. Spring dance is happening, and the gym is booked. Poster is in the works and will be posted. By donation, snacks and drinks. Adults will have to stay with kids and younger siblings. Guest list can be put through a hot lunch. Max quantity 400 or 500 as per fire code, Monique to double check.

## New Business

1. Fill out BCCPAC proxy forms to give to DPAC
2. Start an Informal Bylaw Committee
a. Anyone can look at and make suggestions online regarding bylaw changes
b. We are trying to remove Robert's Rules of Order with a more round table approach
c. We are considering removing the Vice Chair and adding a Communications Role to manage Facebook and the website
d. We'd like to change the designation President with Chair
e. Reduce the amount of executive meetings

Parents brought up how good the Remind app was to keep parents informed but unfortunately it had to be discontinued because it was too expensive. Monique say's the district has an excellent system in place that is easy to use for mass emails.
